Discussion on reporting to the Select Board

Mr. Rickter reported that the Select Board is interested in hearing about what is happening on SCIC in April. A significant piece will be an update on the status of priority ideas:

- Idea #23 Increase revenue from Grants maybe revise the question to consider department specific needs / opportunities - ACTION - revise the initiative and plan next steps
- Idea #33 Civil Service idea is complete.
- Idea #36 review town owned property best use who would we work with to gather information? Facilities? Recreation? Belmont Light? The substation? The old incinerator sight? - ACTION - focus on the old Light Department building next to the police station and provide report to the Select Board
- Idea #39 Establish Budget Guidelines essentially done ACTION Mr. Rickter will check with Anne Helgen on whether this idea can be considered complete.
- Idea #101 PILOT likely the select board will want to wait to see if the Assessors will be appointed. (April 2 ballot question)
- Idea #107 Reevaluate Town Zoning with Master Plan Town Planner should be on this
 ACTION review this with the Select Board to confirm this is a priority.
- Idea #268 Pension Liabilities/Retirement Board Savings it appears a compromise was reached where the investment approach was adjusted to include investments with the state PRIM and the retirement board finalize their membership.
- Idea #269 Transfer Health Care Insurance to the GIC in the hands of the town administrator - TBD - ask Select Board the status
- Idea #275 Real Estate Transfer Fees ACTION Needs SCIC research and followup -Mr. Rickter will look into this. The Housing Trust has a fund funded by CPA and we

- assume that the money generated by new transfer fees would be transferred to this fund for affordable housing in Belmont. Mr. Rickter to look into this further.
- Idea #378 Supplemental Tax Assessment on New Construction ACTION Needs SCIC research and followup. Mr. Rickter to talk with Jennifer Hewitt about how to move this forward. This is directly related to the Board of Assessors - depends on their priorities.
- Idea #391 Allow hotels and B2Bs in bylaws ACTION Needs SCIC research and followup - ask Select Board status and prioritization
- Idea #413 DLS Recommendations on Form of Government wait until after the election and speak to the new Select Board Chair
- Discussion on the status of Belmont Country Club and its reduced property taxes. Town
 Meeting approved a home rule petition to eliminate the 25% property tax discount, but
 it's unclear if further action has occurred ACTION Mr. Rickter to review the Matrix
 from SCIG to see if there is anything on this topic if not we will generate a new item.

Next steps

The committee discussed the possibility that pending the April 2 election results, the SCIC may need a new chair. One possible idea would be to combine the SCIC with the Vision 21 Implementation Committee. Taylor Yates is the chair of that committee.
