I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:36 a.m. by Chair Lovallo. He began by reviewing the morning's agenda. An open discussion on "project information" followed. [An official BHSBC quorum was called at 8:28 a.m.]

II. Treasurer's Report

Ms. Thurston informed the Committee that the following four Invoices are ready for their approval:

Mr. Mooney moved: To approve the Invoice of \$4,156.00. The motion passed unanimously.

Invoice 2: Daedalus \$62,444.51

III. MSBA Submission Update

Chair Lovallo shared an update concerning the August 2, 2018 MSBA staff meeting. The meeting went well, he said, and included a review of "project information" and next steps, namely, an internal team transition within the MSBA as the project shifts into Design and Construction.

IV. Project Funding Agreement Review

Chair Lovallo explained that the Project Funding Agreement (document 3011) was reviewed and will be given to Town Counsel soon for review as well. The anticipated funding amount will be capped at \$80.6 million, by the state, which is based on a complete "spend" of the project budget.

V. General Discussion

Chair Lovallo: Concerning Design and Construction, the construction will likely begin in the summer of 2019 and will involve pre-planning with Skanska. The *target* construction completion date is Fall 2023.

Superintendent Phelan: The Belmont School Department will be developing working groups this school year, and going forward, that will review the curriculum needs for grades 7-12 as well as grades 4-6. Members of these committees will be a mix of School Department administration and teachers. "Project based curriculum" will be developed and reviewed. School operations, including school start times, will be assessed. Staffing needs and position sharing will be evaluated. Based on the projected growth estimates (enrollment), the Belmont School system will need enough staff to support 400 pupils per grade.

VI. Comments from Belmont Residents

Ms. Mary Lewis asked about the contingency plan if there is a "No" vote in November? Chair Lovallo replied that the Project Funding Agreement would be withdrawn by the MSBA. The Board of Selectmen would need to make a decision on next steps. Superintendent Phelan added that this project has the full support of the Board of Selectmen, the School Committee, and Belmont High School Building Committee. Additionally, the MSBA has noted that this is a quality project and fully supports it.

VII. Minutes of Previous Meetings

Mr. McLaughlin moved: To approve the Minutes of 7/19/18. The motion passed unanimously.
