<u>Description:</u> The Economic Development Advisory Committee (EDAC) purpose is to promote balanced, long-term economic development within the Town and to advise the Board of Selectmen on issues concerning policies and zoning that foster commercial and business growth.

- 1. Develop and recommend programs to the Board of Selectmen pertaining to economic development.
- 2. Be a proponent for the current and prospective businesses in Belmont.
- 3. Study, investigate and appraise town-wide economic conditions and trends.
- 4. Promote, assist and encourage the preservation, development and location of new and existing business and commerce.
- 5. Evaluate and advise the town on ideas for zoning changes that may improve the economic vitality of the Town.
- 6. Make recommendations on improving permitting and licensing functions in the Town.
- 7. When requested by the Board of Selectmen, provide a Committee perspective and/or recommendation on specific commercial development proposals.
- 8. Perform other related projects that may be requested by the Board of Selectmen or Town Administrator.

<u>Criteria for Membership:</u> The EDAC shall be appointed by the Board of Selectmen for a term of three years and consist of seven to nine voting members including:

- Individuals with professional experience in commercial real estate financing, development or real estate law.
- 2. Owners of Belmont businesses
- 3. Belmont Business Leaders
- 4. Residents who support the purpose and objectives of the EDAC
- 5. Economic Development Officer as a non-voting member (Jay Szklut)
- 6. One member of the Planning Board
