



# COVID-19 Testing Clinics



In an effort to curb the spread of COVID-19, the Towns of Belmont and Lexington are partnering to offer **free COVID-19 PCR testing** following the upcoming long weekend. There will be two upcoming testing events, and both locations are open to residents of Belmont and Lexington. Testing is available for anyone aged 1 year or older.

PhysicianOne Urgent Care will be providing the testing. You will need to set up an account on their website to register for a COVID-19 test, and to view your test results.

No walk-ins will be accepted, please register in advance.

• Monday, January 17th from 2:00 PM - 5:30 PM

Chenery Middle School, 95 Washington St., Belmont (Indoor testing)
