# 5. Executive Director's Report:

The board further agreed that the employee compensation would be in the form of cash rather than compensatory time and that the grievance would be scheduled with the Belmont Housing Authority Union Attorney. Proposed dates included February 6<sup>th</sup> and February 8<sup>th</sup>.

  Plumbing & Heating, Inc. in the amount of \$142,880.00. The vote was unanimous

- 2. Vote to Approve Belmont Village Wiring Certificate of Final Completion: A motion was made by Gloria Leipzig, seconded by Anne Mahon, to approve the Belmont Village Wiring Certificate of Final Completion for Losordo Electrical Services, Inc. The vote was unanimous (5).

# 7. Report of Committees:

- 1. Belmont Housing Trust: The Belmont Housing Trust is currently reviewing a housing production plan and there will also be a public meeting with the Board of Selectmen.
- 2. Community Preservation Committee: The authority is presently reviewing the possible redevelopment of Sherman Gardens Apartments.
