Paul Roberts provided copies of a public report from CISA (Cyber and Infrastructure Security Agency, part of Department of Homeland Security) on 5G security issues. Information from this report and additional research will be combined with the report Dan Ellard put together on 5G technology in general, and which Dan presented at the 26 June 2019 ITAC meeting, into a comprehensive presentation that will be given to the Select Board on Monday, September 23. Paul and Glenn plan to present it.

Paul reported that he is working with Dana Leavitt of council on aging (BCA) and Alice Melnikoff of BHS to develop a community service project for students to provide personal technical support.

Paul reported that since the subcommittee on 21st century government report to the select board, he has been in discussion with Patrice Garvin to set up a working group to look at remote participation in committee meetings. Paul will also speak with Patrice about a number of the other improvements recommended in the report.

No update from the subcommittee on Technology Cybersecurity and Public Health

Paul reported that he spoke to Patrice Garvin about the town web site and developing a subcommittee / working group to figure out requirements for improvement rather than just hire another consultant / provider and ask them to "fix it".
