Purpose of Meeting - Presentation by Pressley Associates of Recommended Trail Plan

- 1. Ellen Cushman provided a brief introduction of the trails process, introducing Gary Claiborne of Pressley Associates.

- " Trail by trail analysis of existing conditions, goals, recommended actions
- " Emergency access points and trails per the request of the Fire Chief.
- " Trails that could be made "accessible" per National Forestry Service standard
- " Trails that could be considered multi-use, i.e. used by both pedestrians and bicyclists.
