Update on CPC Projects

- 4 projects approved
  - Police Department
  - Clay Pit

  - Tunnel (for school)

Fees

- Will lose use of the field house and pool during construction
- Field house programs will go to Chenery gyms, which is smaller space
- School year membership sales will decrease with less programs due to space loss at High school/will reduce price accordingly
- Dolphins going to Watertown. Tentative - keep price the same for now.
- Minor increases for skate lessons, figure skating
- Conley league increase by \$5 for 2020

- Summer Memberships
  - Keep same price until last day of May then price increases
  - Day passes increase 15/20/25
  - Increase number of non-resident memberships allowed, now 175 families
- S.P.O.R.T. Program
  - Small increases on more competitive programs vs skill developing programs
