### Permit to Allow Dogs on Town of Belmont Athletic Fields 2016 Application

Cost: \$40. (Residents) \$30 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> dog

Non-resident cost: \$60. (Limited to 15 non-resident dogs) No 2<sup>nd</sup> dog discount

Valid until December 31, 2016

#### Permit Requirements

##### Permit is valid only for the following locations:

Belmont High School, Town Field, Grove St, Winn Brook and Pequossette Field

Permit will be issued only to owners who have a current license on file with the Town/City Clerk's office

##### Owner/Walker Shall:

**The town of Belmont will issue NO MORE than 200 permits during a calendar year**

**Limit of 4 dogs per owner/walker (including professional dog walkers)**

\*Have permit in their possession (keep it with your leash or take a picture and keep it on your phone)

\*Clean up after your pet (remember, it is a Town by-law as well as being a courteous pet owner)

\*Accept responsibility for their dog's behavior (your dog should respond to your voice commands)

\*Defer to requests for field use by Town Grounds and School Dept. Personnel and Permitted Groups  
(Soccer, baseball, lacrosse, etc)

\*Dogs must be leashed if you are a spectator at a sporting event

\*Dogs are NEVER allowed on tot-lots (remember, not all children are dog lovers and some are fearful)

150 feet from tot-lots

\*Field use is restricted on all school grounds during school opening and closing hours and recess

\*Parking on Belmont High School Grounds is prohibited while school is in session

**Remember that our parks are for the enjoyment of all, both humans and dogs. Please respect the rights of humans playing on the field and share the space as needed. We are a better community when we cooperate with each other.**

**Failure to comply or a dog's/owner's behavior problems may result in the loss of your permit and may result in a ticket being issued by the Animal Control Officer**

##### \*Attention All Applicants:

Before you are issued your initial permit, you must meet with Belmont's Animal Control Officer, for a pet behavior assessment and a review of the regulations. Dates and location for these assessments will be posted on the Recreation Department webpage and the Facebook pages of both the Belmont Recreation Department and Belmont Animal Control. **Approved:** Belmont Recreation Commission, December 16, 2016
