Ways to License:

Online (Only for renewals with up-to-date rabies vaccination on file with the Town Clerk):

www.belmont-ma.gov, click "Pay Bills", then click "Renew My Pet's License and Pay Online".

American Express, Discover, MasterCard, VISA, and EFTs are accepted. A convenience fee of approximately \$1.22 is added to a \$12 transaction. You will need your pet's four digit 2015 Belmont license number from the license tag or 2015 license receipt.

By Mail or In Person: Town Clerk, Town Hall, 455 Concord Ave, Belmont, MA 02478 (Hours: Mon – Fri 8am – 4pm)

- o Spay/neuter certificate or Veterinarian notation on the Rabies Certificate (if not already on file with the Town Clerk)
- o Check (payable to *Town of Belmont*) or cash
- o By mail, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope in which we will mail a receipt and license tag to you
- o In Person, please remember Belmont prohibits dogs & cats from public buildings (except for service animals).

Renewal pet licenses issued on or before March 15, 2016

Neutered/Spayed: \$12.00 per pet; \$9.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older
Unaltered: \$37.00 per pet; \$34.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older

Renewal pet licenses issued after March 15, 2016

Neutered/Spayed: \$24.00 per pet; \$18.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older
Unaltered: \$49.00 per pet; \$43.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older

Pets licensed for first time in Belmont – regardless of issue date

Neutered/Spayed: \$12.00 per pet; \$9.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older
Unaltered: \$37.00 per pet; \$34.00 if owner is 60 years of age or older

Per General Bylaw §60-200 All dogs & cats must be licensed yearly between January 1 – March 15. **If your pet's rabies vaccination is up-to-date, there is no need to wait for a booster shot, please renew the license now.** Failure to license pets will result in a \$50.00 non-criminal violation in addition to the requirement to license the pet; a late fee is applied. Failure to vaccinate pets will result in a \$100.00 non-criminal violation (MGL Chapter 140).

Pet licenses are valid from January 1st through December 31st
