2015 MINUTEMAN HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS PRODUCT GENERAL INFORMATION

Facility Address: 60 HARTWELL AVENUE, LEXINGTON, MA
Hours of Operation: 9 am - 2 pm

DIRECTIONS: Rt. 2 West to Rt. 128 to Exit 31B, which is 4 and 225 to Bedford. Stay to the right on Bedford St., pass the armory and athletic club on the right. The traffic signal ahead is Hartwell Ave., but you can't turn left there. You must bear right into the special turning lane. You will then cross Bedford St. onto Hartwell Ave. The collection site is on the left just past the traffic signal at the bikeway. It is approximately 10 miles or 15 minutes from the Town Hall. **OR**

Follow Concord Ave. up the hill away from the Police Station in Belmont 2 or 3 miles to Waltham St. turn right on Waltham St., go approximately 2 miles and at the third set of lights take a left at Worthen Rd. Stay on Worthen as it winds around and ends at Bedford St. Take a left onto Bedford St. and follow the directions above. This is 9 miles or 20 minutes from the Town Hall.

Amount to Bring: Belmont's budget does not support a visit every year by every household. It is designed for use every three to five years and for clean-outs for those who are moving. A small trunk load of material will constitute a full load. Try to have at least a half load if you are going to use the site and not go over the full load unless you are doing a total clean-out. Thanks so much for your cooperation!
