The Board of Assessors met at 6:30 p.m.: Mr. Noonan, Mr. Reardon, and Mr. Lavery were present.

The minutes of the previous session were read and accepted as read.

The weekly list(s) of taxes exempted or abated was (were) signed: 11/14/2008.

The Assessors Warrants to Collector Motor Vehicle and Trailer Excise, in the amounts of \$35,080.20, for 2008 Sixth Commitment were signed.

The Board discussed figures relevant to the Tax Classification Hearing and the Residential Exemption.

On motion by Mr. Lavery, seconded by Mr. Reardon, the meeting recessed at 7:00 p.m. The Board of Assessors and the Assessing Administrator, Richard D. Simmons, met with the Board of Selectmen for the purposes of the Tax Classification Hearing. The Board of Selectmen voted not to classify the tax rate and not to have a residential exemption. The Board of Selectmen was informed of the excess levy capacity of \$35,370.25 for Fiscal Year 2009 and signed the Department of Revenue LA-5.

The Board of Assessors meeting reopened at 8:15 p.m. The Board of Assessors discussed the Fiscal Year 2009 Recap Sheet and voted unanimously to establish an overlay of \$815,183.99 and a tax rate of \$11.89 per \$1,000.00 in value for real and personal property.

The Board had voted previously to hold the next meeting on Tuesday, December 2, at 7:30 a.m.

On motion by Mr. Lavery, seconded by Mr. Reardon, passed unanimously, the meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
