**Meeting Minutes**

**July 8, 2015**

- 1) Meeting called to order at approximately 6:10 p.m.
  - a) Present: CPIAC members Heather Ivester, Russell Leino, Vincent Stanton, and Brian Burke; Jeffrey Wheeler, Belmont Office of Community Development; School Committee Member Laurie Graham; and Resident Maura Mullowney
- 2) Mr. Leino volunteered as Secretary for the meeting
- 3) The committee deferred review and approval of the June 24, 2015 Meeting Minutes (drafted by Mr. Burke) to the July 22 meeting
- 4) Mr. Leino provided an update on the June 27 route walk and outreach efforts to other town entities
  - a) It was suggested that Mr. Leino reach out to the Department of Public Works and Belmont Light; Mr. Leino agreed to do so
  - b) Ms. Ivestor suggested that Mr. Leino also reach out to potential commercial abutters
    - i) The committee discussed and agreed to wait to approach potential commercial abutters until after they had produced a draft version of the RFP for the feasibility study
  - c) Mr. Stanton noted that a parcel of MBTA land along one of the proposed routes had recently been sold to a private developer
- 5) The committee continued to discuss potential challenges, focusing on the south side of the commuter rail tracks from the eastern edge of the BHS property to Brighton St.
- 6) The committee agreed to focus the next meeting on finalizing the list of potential challenges and determining the method by which the committee would prioritize the list
  - a) Ms. Ivestor agreed to send to the committee the draft list of potential challenges in advance of the July 22 meeting
- 7) Meeting adjourned at approximately 7:45 p.m.
