**TAC Minutes – November 12, 2015 Meeting**

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 without a quorum present. We started with the Public Hearing re; parking restrictions on Cottage, Myrtle St., Goden St. and Oak St.

On Sept. 8th Anne Marie Mahoney said she couldn't get out of her driveway to get to a meeting because somebody was blocking her driveway. There are disruptions due to the schedule of all the Fall sports teams scheduling games at night under the lights.

Anne Paulsen mentioned that when an override for the new athletic fields and lights was passed years ago parking at the BHS parking lot was going to be enforced. This has never happened. More talk between the BPD and the School Dept. could help. More ticketing could help.

Adam Dash said football, rugby, and soccer games have been a huge disruption for the neighborhood. A detail during games could help blocking driveways on Goden St. & Concord Ave.

Annah Abrams suggested making the streets one way so you can't park on both sides.

Anne Paulsen said the town should enforce the parking @ BHS and send a letter to the School Dept.

Sgt. Mailhot will have the school resource officer talk to Athletic Director to get people to use the BHS parking lot for parking at sports events.

Signs have been made and will be put up by the DPW soon.

If you have somebody blocking your driveway call the BD and we will have an officer ticket the car.

After much discussion on the parking during BHS sports events Peter Curro showed up and a quorum was present. Shortly after Joe Griffin made a motion to put up the signs saying no parking on the side of the streets that have the telephone poles.

Luciene Ribeiro, 614 Trapelo Rd., owner of Children's Connection daycare requested a parking space in front of the daycare.

Larry mentioned certain hours for drop off & pick up.

Glenn said "I don't see how we do this fairly. If we do this here other store will request it too.

After brief discussion it was agreed nothing could be done for the owner of the daycare.

Glen Monte, 28 Washington St. came to speak about the rotary @ the Grove & Washington St. He rides his bike and walks his dog many times a day. There are stop signs @ Bright Rd. & Washington but nothing @ the rotary. He wondered if signs saying Beware. Nobody yields to oncoming traffic may help.

Glenn said the roundabout definitely has helped but it can't do everything. People don't yield to oncoming traffic. 10 accidents have been reported going back 8yrs. 1 due to failure to yield.

Ben talked about a 5 way stop in Waltham in a similar location that has a sign saying one side doesn't yield..

Old business:

Mil St. & Concord Ave was brought up again by Don Mercier.

Joe said Mill and Concord Ave need to be studied again and re-designed.

Sgt. Mailhot said majority of accidents are rear-ends on Mill St.

Peter Curro brought up the truck ban on Brighton St. Where do we stand? How you going to enforce the truck ban on Pleasant St. if they work in town?

Dear Ben,

I'm contacting you in desperation and it's only two days after Labor Day. Last night at 6:00 was a girls varsity soccer game. I live on Goden St. and cars were parked on both sides of the street with traffic trying to advance in both directions. I could not get out of my driveway at 6:45.

I just checked the Belmont High School sports schedule for the fall and discovered (to my horror) that there are ten home soccer and field hockey games scheduled for 6:00 in the month of September. In October there are eight home soccer and field hockey games and three football games scheduled for 6:00. I don't know who at the high school thought this was a good idea, but it is not. The traffic on Concord Ave. at 6:00 is out of control and backed up to the Temple. The side streets are already clogged with commuters. Adding game parking to Oak, Goden, Myrtle and Cottage Streets for a combined 21 games in two months is crazy.

In the interest of everyone's safety - drivers, pedestrians, and residents - I respectfully request that the police department post one side of these streets for no parking on these game days. I know that is quite a lot of work and policing but something terrible, such as an accident, a pedestrian hit by a car, or a medical emergency that cannot be reached will happen. To me, the alternative is posting these streets as no parking and forcing people to park in the high school lots and walk to the field for the game.

I am angered that the high school did not consider the impact on the traffic and the neighborhood when they decided to hold so many 6:00 games. Of course, we do not know how many playoff games will be held on these fields at night in November. Further, the spring schedules have not been posted and I suspect that there will be another 20 or 25 games scheduled at 6:00 or later during the spring.

Thanks so much for your consideration. I'm sure as these games unfold you will be hearing from more residents in this neighborhood. Please let me know if there is anything I can do, such as going to the Traffic Advisory Committee, contacting neighbors, or the school.



We join our neighbors in urging you to grant our neighborhood some relief on game nights (or big game days) at the high school field. For too long now we have endured the problems engendered by the cars parked on both sides of the street, blocking our access to and egress from our driveway. It's not just Friday night football games. We spent over five minutes one Thursday night this fall trying to get out of our driveway, and when we finally managed to get onto the street, there was no way to get up or down. We have seen some ugly scenes -- people who won't give an inch, people yelling at one another from their cars, et cetera.

The police department has been helpful by setting up parking on one side of the street only -- when they remember to do it. Evidently they aren't always alerted to night games, but the high school does publish the schedule on line, and it ought to be possible to initiate the one-side parking more often.

How about some more aggressive ticketing?

Once upon a time we were assured that the parking for games/events would be at the high school lot and that we wouldn't be subjected to the thoughtlessness of game goers, their careless parking, their trash.

A concern for the town, not just the neighborhood, ought to be the impossibility of an unobstructed passage down Goden Street for a fire engine, an ambulance or some other public safety vehicle.

Thank you for your consideration. Please see about giving us relief.

The corner of Bright Road and Washington Street is the site of very frequent near misses between cars going straight on Washington from the rotary and cars taking the left off of Bright toward the rotary. I witness at least two incidents daily. The drivers on Bright do not realize that cars coming from the rotary have no stop sign at Bright. It's only a matter of time before a serious accident occurs there, especially with presence of the bus stops.

Drivers on Bright need to be advised, perhaps with a sign, that cars coming from their left do not stop. My wife called the town to suggest this and was eventually directed to the Police Dept. where the person she talked to promised to send a form to fill out, but we never received it. Could you please direct this to the correct person and advise me on next steps.
