The June 25, 2012 meeting of the Belmont Board of Health was called to order at 5:29 pm by David B. Alper, D.P.M., Chair.

Those present were David B. Alper, D.P.M., Chair, Donna S. David, R.N., M.N., Vice Chair, Robert M. Eisendrath, M.D., Member, Stefan A. Russakow, M.A., R.S., Director, Angela Braun, R.S., Assistant Director, John Maguranis, Animal Control Officer and Veterans Agent, Ellen O'Doherty, Clerk.

The Public Hearing for "Fats, Oils, & Grease Management Regulations" was opened at 5:30 pm.

The Hearing for ADS Ice Cream was opened at 5:30 pm. Mr. Ahmed Shuhibar, Owner/Operator was present. The Board stated they were very disappointed to hear reports of arguments, use of profanity, etc. and that it cannot continue if Mr. Shuhibar wants to continue to be licensed in Belmont. Mr. Shuhibar stated that he was not at fault. The Board advised Mr. Shuhibar that he should remain in his truck and call the police if there is an issue with another driver and they stated that, should there be more incidents reported they would suspend his license to operate. The Board thanked Mr. Shuhibar for coming to the hearing. Hearing closed at 5:42 pm.

A brief discussion was held regarding reviewing the current Ice Cream Truck regulations and the possibility of including a CORI check and specific wording about "waiting customers".

The owner of "Sweet Peaches", Ellen Carter and General Manager, Joe Donovan, was welcomed by the Board. An overview of operation specifics was given and the Board stated they were very happy to have this new establishment opening in town. Ms. Carter and Mr. Donovan exclaimed they were very excited to be opening soon and looking forward to a long, successful business endeavor in Belmont. The Board thanked them for coming.

John Maguranis, Animal Control Officer approached the Board about adopting a "Coyote Management Plan". The Board requested a summary of the management plan and stated they would discuss and review it and thanked John for the clarification.

During Public Participation a group of residents from Crestview Road presented documents and photos relative to a nuisance issue that exists at 53 Crestview Road. This has been a long standing problem at this property and with the property owner. The property owner has recently been notified of the violation and given a date to complete compliance with the nuisance violation. Follow up will continue as well as monitoring of the property. The Board thanked the group for attending and will continue to monitor this address for compliance. The Board encouraged the residents to call the Health Department with any information they feel is relevant.

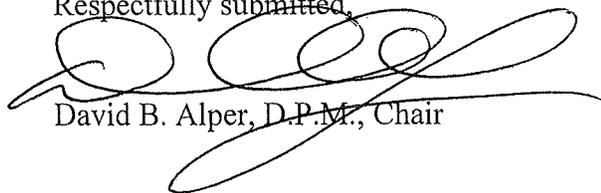
New business included the safety issue relative to the diving board at the Underwood Pool.
