Minutes, June 28, 2005

7:00 p.m.: There being a quorum, Chairman Joseph Barrell opened the meeting.

7:05 p.m. Scenic Road By-Law Public Hearing

James Heigham read the public hearing notice.

Jeffrey Wheeler provided an overview of the status of the application. Unfortunately the landscape architect for 275 Somerset Street had not been in contact with either Karl Haglund (the Planning Board liaison for this application) or Jeffrey Wheeler. Therefore, the Planning Board agreed to dismiss the case until additional information is submitted, at which time a new public hearing can be scheduled.

On a motion seconded by Andy McClurg, James Heigham moved to dismiss the application without prejudice. The motion carried 4-0-1, with Deborah Emello absent.

The Board unanimously expressed its appreciation to Joseph Barrell and congratulated him on serving a Chair for five years.

Joseph Barrell reviewed the success of the Board and urged the Board to continue pushing for a comprehensive review of the Zoning By-Laws.

On behalf of the Planning Board, Andy McClurg also thanked James Heigham for his insightful participation. Karl Haglund added that his acknowledge and institutional memory were invaluable in making decisions.
