



Decorum Standards

Nauset Construction along with its subcontractors, suppliers, visitors and other guests to the Cushing Village project are committed to conduct all construction operations in compliance with the following decorum standards:

- 1.) All tradespersons shall enter the jobsite in a professional and courteous manner. It is imperative that the conduct of all employees is such that we are accepted as guests within the neighborhood. The following guidelines are advanced to achieve this objective. Violation of these guidelines may lead to dismissal from the project:
 - a) Under no circumstances will any worker on the site use or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs during work hours.
 - b) No one shall possess firearms or explosives while on site
 - c) Tradespersons are required to park outside of the immediate Cushing Square shopping district and will not park on any neighborhood streets
 - d) While on site and, while in the Cushing Square shopping district, tradespersons are expected to behave in an appropriate manner that reflects the desire of Nauset Construction to present themselves as a "good neighbor" during the construction period.

- 2.) All work will fully comply with the Town of Belmont bylaws regarding work hours, noise, and other concerns. Typical working hours are Monday through Friday 7:00AM to 3:30PM. All deliveries must be scheduled with Nauset Construction in advance of their arrival in order to limit idling of vehicles which is not allowed on surrounding neighborhood streets.
