Your Notice of Intent (NOI) for coverage under the NPDES general permit for storm water discharges from small MS4s has been reviewed. The NOI appears to be complete. This letter acknowledges the submission of an administratively complete NOI, it does not reflect agency approval of your storm water management program.
