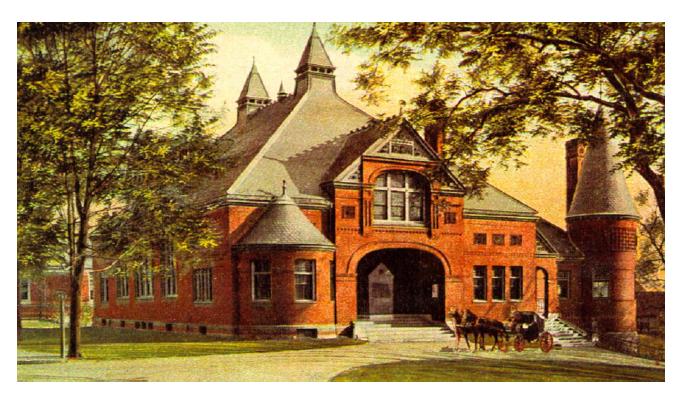

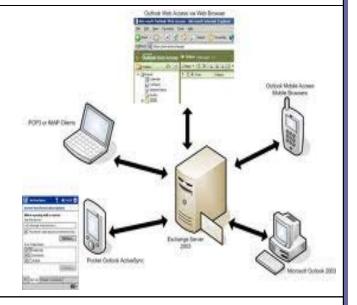

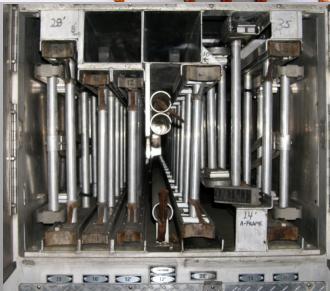

Plan

- Retain current Ladder truck in reserve status

 - Higher points on ISO

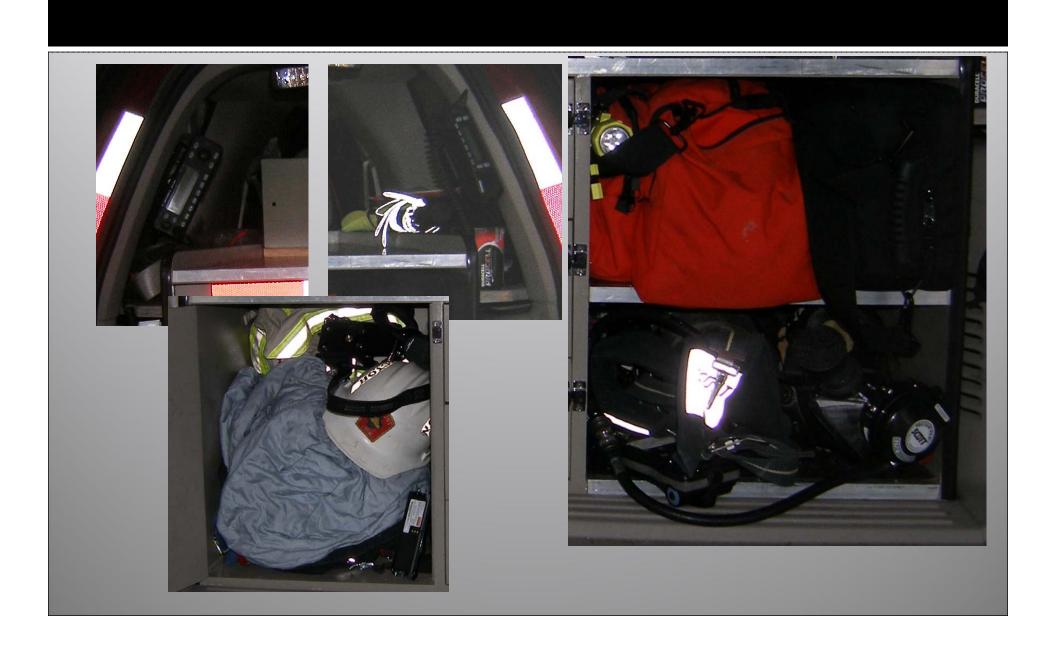

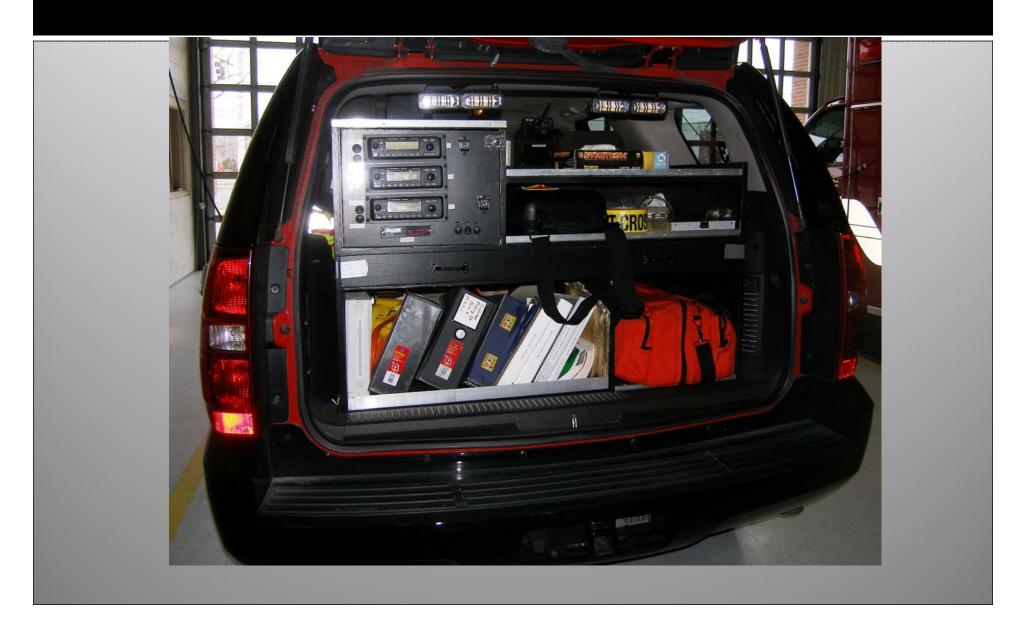

The illustration below was supplied by a company that provides municipal leasing for communities in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. It assumes that an amount of \$900,000 for a 5 year lease purchase with advance payments. At the end of the lease the items would be available for purchase for \$1.00. There are additional fees of approximately \$1000 for documentation and escrow to establish the lease.

EQUIPMENT: Ladder Truck

EQUIPMENT COST: \$900,000.00

PAYMENT STRUCTURES: Tax-Exempt Lease Purchase Five (5) Years

Five (5) Annual Payments of \$191,491.20

First payment due July 1, 2012 and Annual thereafter

RATE: 2.61%
