#### 10 Discuss and Vote School Reserve Fund Requests

- 11 Mr. Lubien reviewed the guidelines for Reserve Fund Requests.
- 12 Mr. DiCologero reviewed the overages in special education due to out-of-district placements and what actions
- 13 were taken to address the deficit. They believe they need about \$250,000 to close out the year, and detailed
- 14 how that money would be used.
- There were several questions and discussion of the expenditures and the request as well as other funds that might be used.
- Mr. Lubien asked if any funds that are not used would be turned back to the town, which Mr. DiCologeroconfirmed.
- 19 There was a discussion of the ARPA fund and remaining funds as well as FEMA reimbursements.
- 20 Ms. Moriarty pointed out the effort that the School Department made to reduce the deficit.
- 21 There were further questions and discussion of the request and other school expenses.
- Motion: Mr. Weis moved approval to transfer \$250,000 out of the Reserve Fund to the School
  Department to fill the anticipated FY23 budget deficit. Ms. Doyle seconded, and the motion passed
  10-3 by roll call vote with Mr. McEachern, Ms. Warner, and Ms. Helgen opposing.

## 25 Covid Related Reserve Fund Request

- Ms. Hewitt explained that this request was made because HRSA Covid funding ended up in Belmont's
  ambulance account by mistake and booked as regular FY20 ambulance revenue. She then explained the
  problems that occurred because of this mistake. She asked that \$14,295.58 be transferred to the Treasurer's
  Banking and Legal Expenses account so that HRSA can be reimbursed.
- 30 There were questions and discussion of the request and how the error occurred.
- Motion: Ms. Helgen moved approval to transfer \$14,295.58 out of the Reserve Fund to the Treasurer's
  Banking and Legal Expenses account. Ms. Doyle seconded, and the motion passed 12-1-0 by roll call
  vote with Ms. Doyle abstaining.

- 44 A. <u>Select Board</u>: Mr. Paolillo reported on the activities of the Select Board and thanked the Warrant 45 Committee for their work over the past year.
- B. <u>Town Administrator</u>: Ms. Hewitt reported that the new Treasurer is starting June 26<sup>th</sup> and reviewed her
  qualifications and experience.
- 48 C. <u>School Committee</u>: Ms. Moriarty reported she will remain as Chair of the School Committee so will also 49 continue to be liaison to the Warrant Committee.
