


## REMOTE VOTING FOR TOWN MEETING

**If you are using your smartphone or tablet to vote:**

Download the Point Solutions app from the App Store (Apple products)  
or Google Play Store (Android Devices).




*This app is not available for Windows Phones, instead use the web browser version ([pg.5](#)).*

Open the app and Sign in (if you are not already)

The app will now ask for a Session ID.

The Session ID will be displayed on the Zoom meeting and given out to  
Town Meeting Members beforehand.


*If the Session ID has changed, it will be displayed at the start of the presentation*




Once you enter the Session ID and click "Join Session," you will see the Presentation Slide




When the presentation advances to voting and polling is open, you will see the screen change to the question and answers along the top of the screen and the responses to choose from along the bottom.



Choose the option 1, 2, or 3 at the bottom and you will notice that your selection is highlighted and the words "Response Received" will show up. You can change your vote if you choose, so long as the polling is open.




When voting is complete, the screen will then change to the graph.  
Your vote will be displayed at the bottom of the screen  
to confirm that your vote was received.




If you are using a desktop or laptop computer:

Go to [www.ttpoll.com](http://www.ttpoll.com) and click “Sign In” at the top right




Once you have signed in, you will see Hello YOUR NAME as below.  
Enter the Session ID and click “Join Session”.  
The Session ID will be displayed on the Zoom meeting and given out to  
Town Meeting Members beforehand.

*Note that the screen will NOT show the words "Response Received" to confirm your vote like the mobile app will but your vote will be tinted pink.*
