The Board signed the Assessors Warrant to Collector Motor Vehicle and Trailer Excise for 2017 Fifth Commitment in the amount of \$125,453.48.

The Board reviewed the memorandum from Floyd Carman, Town Treasurer & Collector, dated 9/15/17, requesting personal property abatements in regards to several businesses for fiscal years 2012 through 2017.


The Board and Mr. Dargon met with Mr. Don Mercier and Mrs. Tommasina Olson to discuss the deferral program and a home repair fund for low income elders.

The Board and Mr. Dargon discussed: 1) placing a warrant article in order to increase the senior work-off program reduction (from \$1,000 to \$1,500), and 2) increase in the revaluation account because of a project with the goal of gathering up-to-date images of residential properties (most images are 20 years old), both to be potentially requested in the FY2019 budget.
