FY16 Projects

Warrant Committee, Capital Budget Committee and Board of Selectmen Update

The project sponsors have submitted their responses to the questions from the Warrant Committee. The Warrant Committee will discuss the CPA project proposals at their March 25, 2015 meeting. Floyd Carman, Anthony Ferrante (or a representative from the Recreation Commission), Gloria Leipzig, Lisa Harrington, Margaret Velie, and project sponsors will be in attendance.

1853 Homer House Rehabilitation and Restoration Project

The Homer House project sponsors have received detailed information from Town Counsel regarding historical deed restrictions. Although a deed restriction does not need to be filed prior to funding approval, Lisa Harrington stressed it must be apparent during the Town Meeting presentation that project sponsors have exercised due diligence. Should the project receive Town Meeting approval, Town Counsel can provide a cost estimate for the appropriate deed restriction.

FY16 CPA Budget

FY14 Project Monitor Reports

Landscape Plan for Intergenerational Walking Path at Clay Pit Pond – A draft of the master plan is expected to be completed soon.

FY15 Project Monitor Reports

(Belmont Village) Electrical Upgrade - Interior Wiring - It is anticipated that electrical work on the first two apartments will be completed by May 2015. While initially it was hoped that more apartments would be upgraded prior to the May 2015 Town Meeting,

this would require turning off the power to resident-occupied units during winter months. A backup generator could be provided by the contractor to accommodate the affected residents, but it is more logical to simply delay work until the spring.

First Time Homebuyer Assistance – The initial advertisement for the program is expected to be published by the April CPC meeting, which will begin the 60-day application timeline.

Underwood Pool – Although work has been delayed due to inclement weather, project sponsors remain confident about the anticipated July 2015 completion date.

Winn Brook Field Renovation - Michael Trainor will contact project sponsors for confirmation regarding the project's completion status.

Open Space and Housing Inventory Discussion

Gloria Leipzig, Margaret Velie, and Mary Trudeau are currently in the process of editing the Open Space and Housing Inventory. Once these changes have been made, the Inventory will be distributed to the CPC for further review and discussion.
