Re: CHA Amendment for Sampling Clay Pit Pond - UPDATED

Dear Sir:

CHA is hereby submitting a fee proposal for additional services to perform sampling of the water in Clay Pit Pond as discussed with the Town Administrator's office, the Town's Board of Health, and their water quality experts. We will be engaging McPhail Associates who will assist in collecting the water samples and they will be using a third party to perform the laboratory testing. We understand the Town of Belmont, with their consultants, will be performing the risk assessment based on the testing data provided by McPhail Associates. This additional scope for McPhail Associates will be a continuation of their Geotechnical and Geo-environmental services on the project.

The fee adjustment to CHA's contract would be:

Total for CHA Amendment	\$33,600.
CHA 5% Mark Up on Consultant	<u>\$ 1,600.</u>
McPhail's Budget 9/6/22	\$32,000.

This is based on one set of samples only – if additional sampling is required for differing conditions, the added cost will be addressed based on the revised criteria.
