GRANT RESTRICTIONS

Q: Can the grants be used for any needs we have, such as offsetting gaps in our foundational operating budget?

A:

- As a general rule, no. The grants all originate in the COVID era, so all must be applied to address COVID-related challenges.
- Most are required to be used for "supplemental" purposes to pay for new types of expenses that we are not already incurring.
- All must address a COVID-related need (and while, hypothetically, everything is COVID-related during this time, the grants contain some very specific language).
- They are not akin to a "blank check" for districts; districts are somewhat limited in their discretion.
