#### 6. Agenda Items for Board Vote:

Board Vote to Authorize Expenditure of Formula Funding: Because the submission
of the Belmont Housing Authority Capital Improvement Plan is contingent upon the
Executive Director attending dhed training sessions during the Summer, a board vote is
required to utilize formula funding until the CIP has been submitted to and approved
by dhed. Since the board had previously approved the electrical upgrades at Belmont
Village, a motion was made by Leo Saidnawey, seconded by Donna Brescia, to
approve the expenditure of formula funding for the replacement of the existing
underground cables at Belmont Village. The vote was unanimous (4).
