Paul Roberts moved to adopt the minutes of the 8 July 2019 meeting of the ITAC 21st Century Government Subcommittee Paul Roberts: yes David Goldberg: yes Note: Paul and David were the only attendees who were members of the 21st Century Government Subcommittee Motion carried, minutes accepted as is. Glenn Wong moved to adopt the March 11, 2020 meeting of the Subcommitte on Technology, Cybersecurity and Public Health (S-TCPH). Charles Smart and Dave Petto arrived after the minutes were voted on. Paul Roberts raised the topic of the Belmont Police Department's email service bouncing legitimate emails. Dave Petto reported that he spoke with John Steeves, the Police Department's IT manager, who in turn

reported that he is working with his firewall vendor to find a means of

resolving their spam issue without blocking legitmate email. Paul suggested that the Town IT manage the email for the Police Department as it does for most other departments. Dave noted that he cannot make that decision - it has to come from the Select Board.

Paul Roberts raised the topic of the Op Ed urging the Select Board to vote to allow remote deliberation in committee meetings, as ITAC voted to do at the 28 October 2021 meeting. Paul brought up a new draft of the Op Ed for review as he had received some feedback. We made some changes to address those concerns. David Goldberg made a motion to adopt and send in the amended version of the Op Ed.

The motion carried. Paul reported that he sent the earlier version of the Op Ed to the Select Board and received an answer that suggested the board does not see it as a priority. Paul will submit the Op Ed to the Belmont Citizen Herald for publication.

Paul Roberts brought up our coordination with the Structural Change Impact Group (SCIG). Paul Roberts and Dave Goldberg represented ITAC at the 5 November 2021 SCIG meeting. Dave Goldberg reported that he has an action to contact Dave Petto to ask about the potential for improved usage of the MUNIS system and opportunities to streamline purchasing, particularly software.

Paul Roberts reported on the most recent Web Site Renewal committee meeting. They saw a presentation from Granicus, a competitor to Civics Plus who we currently use to host the Belmont site. Paul gave an overview of the presentation and its claims, and contrasted it with what we have today. The Web Site Renwal committee needs to do more review before deciding on whether to recommend a switch.
