### Review Draft Description for Proposed Capital Planning Committee

Chris Doyle reported on a review of the capital planning process for eighteen Massachusetts towns. Arlington had well-written policies that can provide template for Belmont. All towns combined short and long-term planning in the same committee. The committee agreed that one committee is the best approach due to practical problems with alignment, scheduling, and communication. There was also agreement to avoid too large a committee.

A discussion followed on the best balance between moderator appointees and designates from committees. Currently there are five of each with the representatives from other areas being Selectboard, Town Treasurer, School Committee, Warrant Committee, and Energy Committee.

There was agreement that town employees should not have voting rights.

#### Plan for report to Town Meeting

The committee discussed what should be presented to Town Meeting. Topics included the expansion of planning effort, concentration on managing big projects, the longer planning horizon, transparency to the project selection process, inventory of capital assets and investment requirements, and the annual nature of the capital process.
