Dear Ms. Freni

The Office of Community Development is in receipt of your sign permit application for your proposal to crect wall signs and a freestanding sign at 277 Trapelo Road located in the Local Business III (LBIII) zoning district.

Your application has been denied because it does not comply with the current Town of Belmont Zoning By-Law. More specifically, §5.2.5 4 b) 1 and §5.2.5 b) 3 of the Zoning By-Law. These sections of the Zoning By-Law allows multiple attached signs and standing signs by Special Permits granted by the Planning Board.

- 1. The proposed "sign 2a" can be signed off administratively in connection with the removal of the existing sign 2a"
- 2. The application doesn't include the wall area where proposed "sign 3a" is located. We cannot verify if the proposed "sign 3a" would meet the specific requirements found in §5.2.5 4 b) 1 without the additional information from you.
- 3. Is there proposed signage to replace the existing signage on top of the drive-up teller?
- 4. The proposed "sign 12" doesn't meet the requirement in §5.2.5 b) 3. It should be reduced so that it can be granted as a special permit from the Planning Board.

You should alter your plans to conform to the current Town of Belmont Zoning By-Law and resubmit any requested information in order to determine your next steps. If you choose this option, please contact the Office of Community Development to schedule an appointment with Robert Hummel, Senior Planner.




