Since 2016 The Town of Belmont has received 1,554 Animal Calls. Of that total number of calls 10 were initiated from Rutledge Rd: 9 calls for nuisance wildlife and 1 call reporting a fox den (2021). There were two Animal Calls that were initiated on Park Rd: 1 call for a fledgling and 1 call for a sick/injured fox (2016). There were 10 calls initiated on Prospect St: 2 calls complaining about coyotes, 1 call for an injured deer (2021), 1 call requesting for deer to be removed from the area and 4 calls for nuisance wildlife. The following surrounding roads (Knox St, Wellesley Rd, Ross Rd, Beatrice Circle, Clifton St and Village Hill Rd) have had a total of 18 Calls for service regarding wildlife: 1 Hawk, 2 Coyote, 3 Rabbit, 3 Raccoon, 1 Squirrel and 8 nuisance wildlife calls.

There have been no rare animal sightings reported in this area. There have been no endangered species sighting reported in this area. The calls for service initiated in this area are typical of the calls received throughout Belmont on a daily basis.
