Subject: Amend Order of Conditions to Remove Dugout Shelters at Baseball and Softball Fields

At the request of the Brendan Grant Foundation, the Belmont Middle and High School Building Committee [Building Committee] is considering elimination of the planned dugout shelters at the baseball and softball fields as part of the construction effort underway under our current building permit. The alternate solution being proposed is for the Brandan Grant Foundation and/or the Building Committee, to change to wooden structures at the baseball field, similar to the previous installation that existed prior to construction at the baseball field (see attached photos), and possibly something similar at the softball field. This installation effort will take place late this year or early next year so they will be ready for next year's playing season. The effort to consider an alternate design, and obtain the necessary funding and approvals, has yet to get underway.

In consideration of these changes, the Building Committee is requesting that the Planning Board amend the Project Order of Conditions to alter the approved plans and remove these dugout shelters as part of the completion of the project. Please see the attached plan indicating the proposed shelters, clouded in red, to be eliminated as part of the current building permit.

The Committee appreciates the Planning Board's consideration in this matter.
