I. New Business

Valley Hockey League Rink Rental: BYHA is charging VHL \$240.00 per hour for ice time for VHL games (72 hours worth of ice). BYHA is paying Town of Belmont \$225.00 per hour for ice. The differential over the 72 hours is \$3600.00

- Sub-lease came to the Town's attention via a direct communication from VHL who objected to the rental rate they were being charged and needed resolution on the rate as they were looking to complete league scheduling week of Oct. 6.
- The Town was unaware VHL pays BYHA for ice time for its games.
- Confusion over how ice time is broken down and billed (1 hour or 50 minutes).
- **Approved Motion:** Town will absorb the disputed differential of \$3600.00 to allow the VHL to move forward with scheduling (by charging BYHA \$200 per hour for ice instead of \$225.00).
- Approved Motion: RD will ask BYHA for \$1500 toward the \$3800 revenue loss so that RD programs will not lose '14-'15 budgeted funding (such programs include SPORT, vacation week camps, etc.)
- Going forward, VHL will pay Town of Belmont directly via the RC. BYHA will continue to hold the ice scheduling component of the VHL relationship.
- II. Underwood Pool Update Fundraising continues. If funding goal is met, Selectmen will vote on accepting lowest bid to construct pool week of Oct. 13
