General and Ongoing Items:

TENNIS COURTS

- The new BHS plan continues to remain as is with no plan for Tennis courts on the high school campus
- An alternative and likely best option is to add 1-2 courts to the 4 already at Winn Brook as per MIAA rules there needs to be minimum of 5 courts to run an MIAA match
- 1 is feasible 2 may be very tight, but 2 would be optimal because then both men's and women's teams could practice at the same time
- The sight still needs to be investigated for drainage, space, positioning etc feasibility
- The rec commission voted to move in favor of investigating adding 1-2 tennis courts for the high school tennis teams at the Winn Brook pending a feasibility study. All members present voted in favor, no nay, no abstentions
- There is also a request to remove the pickle ball lines from the Winn Brook tennis courts as this
 can be confusing to the tennis players with multiple lines. The commission has declined to move
 on this request at this time
