Meeting Minutes, 15 June 2016

1) 6:10 pm, Meeting called to order

Attending: CPIAC members R. Leino, Chair; M. Cicalese, Secretary; V. Stanton; B. Burke; Jeffrey Wheeler, Belmont Town Planning Office; resident Cosmo Caterino; guest, Mr. Leino, Sr.

- 2) Meeting commenced with the reading and approval of previously held meeting minutes. Whereby, 28 April and 4 May were voted upon and accepted with minor edits noted, and 4 May was to be re-typed with additional information added.
- 3) 6:30 pm, Mr. Leino, continued with several updates, most notable the BOS Chair Paolillo's letter to MassDOT, MBTA, and DCR regarding the Town's selection of a contractor to proceed with the Community Path Feasibility Study.
- 4) 6:45 pm, Mr. Stanton continued with an update that the Mass. Architectural Access Board (AAB) granted a 10-year reprieve to the MBTA to make Waverley Station ADA compliant so that the MBTA could use their money to upgrade more frequented accessed stations. He also mentioned that a great deal of interest on path access is occurring in Waltham near the Route 128 renovation of the former Raytheon property, whereas there has been very little interest or discussion with the Beaverbrook/Waltham to Belmont connection.
- 5) 6:50 pm, Mr. Leno then continued with the all-important topic of the Belmont-Pare "Introduction" meeting. After a lengthy and in depth discussion, it was agreed that the meeting content remain fairly high-level with recommendations to include: an introduction, a review of CPIAC's work and charges, Pare's expectations, Q&A, and schedule. It was also noted that Board of Selectmen will be invited and may be in attendance.
