- 3. Eastern End (Belmont Center Railroad Bridge to Brighton Street) Wednesday, March 8

The purpose of these meetings will be to present the consultant's conceptual design for the alternatives carried forward from the CPAC, as well as potential alternates, for each segment discussed at the meeting. All views and comments made at the meeting will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.
