Project Name: 308 Water Quality Sewer Rehabilitation Project

Project Description: The Town of Belmont is under Federal order to make repairs to the sanitary sewer system to correct infiltration of sewage into the storm drain system.

Length of Project: This project is substantially complete as of June 1, 2006

Notes: This project has been approved by the Board of Selectmen. It is being executed under the authority of the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection and the Federal Environmental Protection Agency. The purpose of this project is to improve the quality of water in the Town's receiving waters. These waters include Little Pond, Winn's Brook and Blair Pond.

Additional Information: The investigation and repair of the sanitary sewer system is an ongoing program aimed at eliminating pollution in the Town's brooks, ponds, and streams. This program involves the investigation and evaluation of the sanitary sewer and storm drain system, and the design and repair of those systems as required. The program is currently targeting three neighborhoods: Livermore Road/Dalton Road, Oliver Road, Westlund Road. Further investigation will continue in other neighborhoods in the near future.
