Roger related that Erick Seabasian, Manager of the Urban Forestry Program, would do a write up for the Citizen Herald by late Feb/early March.
- Roger related that we should contact Joe DeStefano on the tree by-law and the Stretch Code initiatives for his feedback and possible support.
- Chris related that we should reach out to the Real Estate business community in a similar way, suggesting that Steve xxx at Century 1 would be a good candidate.
