Administrative Overview (June Howell)

- A Budget: Budget/Expenses \$670,000.00, Annual revenues approx \$800,000 Difference to Town general funds, not back to RC or RD Specifically.
 - David Kane recommended a closer look at budget and line items as Agenda item for November meeting

- BPS has first priority for all its own facilities, RD. second priority at the permission of the BPS, then others
 - Lynn Findlay had a question about the private BATS Swim program as an apparent exception to this policy
 - Katy asked if BPS kept transparent records of what programs pay for School
 facility use to ensure parity amongst programs. Dolphins only pays a custodial
 fee to the school but they are a Town program. Is BATS, a private program,
 paying a facility use fee such as other programs pay (ie; BYHA purchases ice
 time from RD).
- BPS has first priority on <u>ALL</u> field scheduling until 4:00pm, RD second priority, then others
- RD does not have access to any BPS facilities/fields until after 7:00pm and does not have access to the Beech Street Center until after 4:00pm. Multiple Town organizations and non-profit groups also schedule this space.
- C Program Overview (June Howell):

- June briefly explained the programs the RC supports. The Programs extend beyond traditional sports. Luke Ferreira provided and example of the Parkour (urban gymnastics Program as new programming reaching out to Town. - June also provided an overview of the Belmont SPORT (Special Programs Organized for Recreation Time) special needs program which serves ages 6-60+ and is open to residents of Belmont and surrounding Towns (some of whom assist with funding some programs but bulk of funding comes from Belmont).
