Joel Semuels reported that he had contacted the town counsel regarding the status of the current lease on the Our Lady Parish Hall which expires as of 5/06. The archdiocese has the right to sell the property, however, the Town has the right to make the first offer. If it is sold it is hoped that we would be able to negotiate an extension, since a new senior center would not be built by then.

The new slate of officers were presented and each was elected by the board unanimously. The officers are: Chair – Neil Hegarty; Vice Chair – Barbara Miranda; Treasurer – Joe Horner, and Secretary (on a rotating basis) – John Brusch, Anne Lougee, Tom Morabito, Joel Semuels and Phyl Solomon.
