

November 29, 2010

The Board of Assessors met at 7:45 a.m.: Mr. Reardon, Mr. Lavery and Mr. Millane were present.

The minutes of the previous session were read and accepted as read on motion by Mr. Reardon, seconded by Mr. Lavery and passed unanimously.

The following bills/vouchers were ordered paid:

The weekly list(s) of taxes exempted or abated was (were) signed: 11/12/2010 and 11/19/2010.

The Board reviewed and discussed the draft of the FY2012 budget request of the Assessors' Office presented by Mr. Simmons.

The Board signed the Assessors Warrants to Collector Motor Vehicle and Trailer Excise Commitments: 2009, 12th commitment, in the amount of \$114.38 and 2010, 6th commitment, in the amount of \$45,880.32.


The Board discussed figures relevant to the Tax Classification Hearing and the Residential Exemption.

On motion by Mr. Reardon, seconded by Mr. Lavery, the meeting recessed at 8:45 a.m. The Board of Assessors and the Assessing Administrator, Richard D. Simmons, met with the Board of Selectmen for the purposes of the Tax Classification Hearing. The Board of Selectmen voted not to classify the tax rate and not to have a residential exemption. The Board of Selectmen was informed of the excess levy capacity of \$192,274.35 for Fiscal Year 2011 and signed the Department of Revenue LA-5.

The Board of Assessors meeting reopened at 9:20 a.m. The Board of Assessors discussed the Fiscal Year 2011 Recap Sheet and on motion by Mr. Lavery, seconded by Mr. Millane voted unanimously established an overlay of \$576,197.42 and a tax rate of \$13.24 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value for real and personal property.

The Board voted to hold the next meeting on Wednesday, December 22, 2010, at 7:45 a.m.

On motion by Mr. Lavery and seconded by Mr. Millane passed unanimously, the meeting adjourned at 9:30 a.m.
