The Board of Assessors met at 6:30 p.m.: Mr. Lavery, Mr. Reardon and Mr. Noonan were present.

The minutes of the previous session were read and accepted as read.

The following bills/vouchers were ordered paid:

The weekly list(s) of taxes exempted or abated was (were) signed: 11/13/2009, and 11/20/2009.

The Board signed the Assessors Warrant to Collector Motor Vehicle Excise and Trailer Excise, Commitment 2009 6th.

The Board discussed figures relevant to the Tax Classification Hearing and the Residential Exemption.

On motion by Mr. Reardon, seconded by Mr. Noonan, the meeting recessed at 7:00 p.m. The Board of Assessors and the Assessing Administrator, Richard D. Simmons, met with the Board of Selectmen for the purposes of the Tax Classification Hearing. The Board of Selectmen voted not to classify the tax rate and not to have a residential exemption. The Board of Selectmen was informed of the excess levy capacity of \$ 16,709.18 for Fiscal Year 2010 and signed the Department of Revenue LA-5.

The Board of Assessors meeting reopened at 7:20 p.m. The Board of Assessors discussed the Fiscal Year 2010 Recap Sheet and voted unanimously to establish an overlay of \$ 762,474.21 and a tax rate of \$ 12.18 per \$1,000.00 in value for real and personal property.

The Board voted to hold the next meeting Friday, December 18, 2009 at 7:45 a.m.

On motion by Mr. Lavery, seconded by Mr. Reardon, passed unanimously, the meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
