The Assistant Director's Report (on file in the Health Department) was discussed and the Fats, Oil and Grease Regulations are still being drafted. The City of Boston has not yet passed their Nail Salon Regulations which will be the model for the rest of the State.

The Animal Control and Veterans Officer Reports were reviewed.

The Youth and Family Services Report was discussed briefly and the Board commented that it was a great format and very informative.

Complaints were discussed.

The next meeting of the Belmont Board of Health is scheduled for January 25, 2012 at 5:15 pm.
