- Millwork fabricator selected
- Submittal process ongoing
- Commencement in August 2008

WELLINGTON SCHOOL

- Funding is being discussed
- Debt exclusion to occur in 2009
- Projected Cost: \$45-50 million with 40% reimbursement from the state
- Building committee to be reconvened
- Future enrollment at the school is now being studied
- Approved by State for feasibility study and "new" building
- Design team to be approved by State on May 28
- School occupancy anticipated to be Fall 2011
