Presentation and Discussion

Dick introduced Chuck Sherwood of Community Media Visioning Partners. Chuck presented work that needed to be done, primarily in three areas:

- Publishing of a community needs assessment
- Creation of a non-profit corporation (including community meetings, needs assessment)
- Negotiation of the license with the cable provider

This kicked off a wide-ranging discussion about funding, negotiation, schedule, and the role of the committee. One important idea was that we would be establishing a community media center, rather than continuing the current public access television station.

The committee voted to have Chuck submit a proposed workplan and timeline. [Chuck submitted this document by the end of the week.]
