- Chairman French called the meeting to order at 10:06 am.
- Water Manager Mr. Bishop presented the issue with water/sewer bill #547010 from August 31, 2013 for 81 Richardson Road. The customer is requesting a one time water and sewer adjustment. There was a brief discussion to grant relief to this customer as requested. Chairman French made a motion for a one time water and sewer adjustment based on 50% of the average usage for the prior two similar quarters. Seconded by Mr. Shea.

The customer is requesting a one-time irrigation adjustment and disputing the graph accuracy on the bill. There was a brief discussion to grant relief to this customer as requested.

If there were no billing errors the board would grant a one-time irrigation adjustment based on 50% of the average usage for the prior two similar quarters not to exceed \$500.00.
