As you are aware, several motions were voted on by the MCAC Committee during the meeting. In particular, I am forwarding the motion regarding the RNAV Study Runway 33L departures proposals. The following motion was voted unanimously:

"To request that the FAA commit to developing a procedure for Runway 33L that disperses jet departures, specifically referring to geographic deconcentration of flight tracks more equitably than the current RNAV SID."
