Procurement Methods

A Limited Dealers

(on a State Contract)

- Belmont can purchase exact pieces from furniture fair that have been selected.
- The dealer would provide us their best pricing (for both unit cost and install) Using either the MSBA CPP, MHEC, their own discount, or any other state approved consortium in compliance with the Ch. 30B Uniform Procurement Act.
- Ideal for scheduling/omit public bidding time and processing.
- Vendors have promised to work within our allotted installation value.
- A manageable list of vendors will help ensure a smooth installation and punch-listing process.
- Future outreach service for products is easier with limited dealers.
- The vendor selected can make a presentation of their services and will be able to answer all questions. (If requested.)

B Multiple Dealers

(on a State Contract)

- Belmont can purchase exact pieces from furniture fair that have been selected.
- Each dealer would provide us their best pricing (for both unit cost and install) – Using either the MSBA CPP, MHEC, their own discount, or any other state approved consortium in compliance with the Ch. 30B Uniform Procurement Act.
- The owner is NOT required to take the lowest quote.
 This process allows for a price comparison for the unit cost and installation fee.
- Impacts schedule; PW will need to compile packages to send out to multiple dealers that are all on a contract.
- Each vendor can be asked to present on their services, if this is requested.

C Public Bid

- No guarantee that the owner will get the exact piece that they have selected and specified.
- The owner is required to take the lowest bidder.
- In our experience, when we public bid products the pricing comes back similar to the consortium pricing and on some occasions, it is a cost saver.
- Not ideal for schedule; public bids will add more time to the process.


