



COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS IN BELMONT









Belmont has the authority to prohibit an Adult Use Marijuana establishment from locating within a predetermined distance of public and private schools.

The AUMEOD proposes a 300 foot buffer, which is consistent with the existing Medical Marijuana Overlay District

- 3. Marijuana Independent Testing Laboratory
- 4. Marijuana Product Manufacturer
- 5. Marijuana Products
- 6. Marijuana Retailer



Permit Process

The AUMEOD identifies the Planning Board as the Special Permit Granting Authority

The Special Permit process requires a Public Hearing with notification to abutters and the opportunity for public input.

BEYOND ZONING, THERE IS ADDITIONAL REGULATION AND REVIEW REQUIRED




2. Massachusetts Cannabis Control Commission (CCC)


- Application three packets: Application of Intent, Background Check CORI, Management and Operations Profile – Disposal and Security Plans
- Signage no marijuana symbols/logos
- 500' Buffer to public and private schools (k-12)
- Municipality to review the complete application (3 packets) and determine if it is in compliance with local by-laws (60 days to respond)
- License Issued: Requires annual renewal; Non-transferable
- On-going Operation Restrictions




- Application
- Customer/Anyone who enters store must be at least 25 years old ID upon entry
- Sales Permit Issued: Requires annual renewal; Non-transferable
- Operation Restrictions Self-service displays/sampling are prohibited
