Select Board Initiatives:

Edward J. Collins Center Financial Organization Structure Review – Presentation August 3rd:

In Summer 2021, the Town Administrator secured a Community Compact Grant by request of the Select Board which allowed her to engage with the Collins Center at UMass Boston to review the financial organization structure of the Town of Belmont. Municipal finance has become more complex over the years, and it is critical that the Town adjust to ensure efficient operations. After dozens of interviews, a review of past reports, and using knowledge of best practices, the consultants have delivered a report, <u>available on the town website</u>, which offers 19 specific recommendations to enhance the Town's fiscal operations. Many of those recommendations will be taken up by various boards and committees, and potentially Town Meeting.

Hybrid Meeting Tools:

In partnership with the Belmont Media Center, the Town Administrator and Select Board have announced a new tool for incorporating remote participation at Town Committee, Board, and Commission meetings taking place in-person at Town Hall. Hybrid participation will allow members of the public to watch and engage in conversation with committee members remotely. The new technology has been installed in the Select Board Meeting Room and has been used successfully throughout Select Board meetings in July. The technology is planned for 2 or 3 additional locations. The Town Administrator's Office will be communicating with Committee chairs about how to schedule hybrid meetings.

Community Updates:

Belmont Fire Department

The month of July was an extremely busy time for public education and community outreach by our firefighters. We participated in numerous block parties, day camp events, and even hosted the Middlesex County Sheriffs Camp. providing demonstrations for the attendees.

During the month of July, a new firefighter joined the ranks of the department. Alec Thompson who came to the department after already attending the Massachusetts Firefighting Academy will undergo several weeks of in-house training and introduction to BFD equipment and polices, after which he will be assigned to a shift in the Operations Division.

After receiving a number of smoke alarms from the City of Boston, through the Division of Fire Services, the BFD held a smoke alarm give away. In less than four hours the department was able to distribute our entire allotment of approximately 175 smoke alarms to people who came to headquarters on Trapelo Rd. Every smoke alarm installed in Belmont can help save a life!
