- WHEREAS: Celebrating Transgender Day of Remembrance and Transgender Awareness Month influences awareness and provides support and advocacy to the transgender community and is an opportunity to take action and to engage in dialogue to build acceptance and advance equal rights.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Select Board of the Town of Belmont hereby proclaims November 20th as the Transgender Day of Remembrance to honor and memorialize the transgender lives lost to anti-transgender hate and violence.
